

## Prohibited items – Rampton Hospital

As Rampton is a high secure hospital, we have strict procedures as to what can or cannot be brought into the Hospital. This is to ensure everybody's safety.

The following items are prohibited and will not be allowed into the Hospital:

- Large bags, holdalls, etc
- Cameras and tape recorders
- Mobile phones or radio scanners
- Compact discs, floppy discs or USB sticks
- Sharp implements or weapons
- Lighters or matches
- Food
- Tobacco
- Drinks
- Chewing gum or sweets
- Safety pins or brooches
- Alcohol
- Drugs
- Electronic items including laptops and iPads
- Glass items
- Smart watches and fitness trackers
- Any laundry products

Medicine - you can take in only the amount that you require for the duration of your visit.

Visitors must not give patients money or any personal documents such as a driving license, passport, National Insurance cards or credit cards.
