

Council of Governors – Election Update

Council of Governors meeting

23 January 2018

The Trust commenced its election in November 2017 to fill 10 vacancies across both public and staff constituencies. The vacancies had arisen through those reaching the end of their initial 3 year term of office, and some having to stand down due to personal and capacity issues.

The nominations stage closed on Tuesday 19 December and the following nominations were received:

Where the number of vacancies exceeds the number of nominations received, those who have nominated will automatically take a seat on the Council of Governors. All others will be carried as vacancies until the next election.

On Thursday 11 January 2018 the election opened for those contested constituencies. The election will close on Friday 2 February with the outcome being formally announced on Monday 5 February. All nominees will be notified by either email or letter regarding the success of their election.

All successfully elected governors will be expected to attend an induction meeting during February prior to the commencement of their term of office on Thursday 1 March 2018.

If you have not yet voted in this election please ensure you cast your vote before 5pm on Friday 2 February.
