

Privacy statement – Recovery College enrolment form

How we use your information

The personal information you enter via this form is used to register your interest in attending our Recovery College. We will then contact you to discuss this. Your information is only shared with the people who need to process your request.

Who can access your information

A small number of Trust staff have access to information from the form. These include staff at the Recovery College and a team of website administrators, who have access to the forms for support purposes. A small number of staff at VerseOne, who host and provide technical support for our website, also have access to the forms. How we store your information

When a web form has been submitted, an email notifying the Recovery College team is sent. This email contains no personal information. The email contains a link to a secure web address where the form can be securely downloaded and saved within our protected Trust computer network.

How long we store your information for

We store personal information for as short a time as possible. Your details will be deleted from our web system as soon as a member of the Recovery College team has downloaded your referral.

If you choose to enrol, your details will be stored on our Trust systems to allow us to provide you with Recovery College services.

Removal of your information from our records

You are entitled to request that we remove any personal information we have about you stored within our systems at any time. Please note that this right is not absolute in relation to healthcare and there may be times when this does not apply.
